KISEPÍSIM Great Moon Pronounced- Kiss- ee-pee-sim

Happy New Year and welcome to 2024! An exciting new year filled with new possibilities. Traditionally during this time of year and for the next two months, we experience some of the harshest cold weather conditions. A time when all living things need extra kindness and care to survive to cold.

So far in our moon journey together we have discovered that the Cree language is very descriptive. Words are chosen to create a picture in your mind. Each moon's name has been based on what we see happening on the earth around us. This is why different groups of First Nations people have different names for the moons depending on where they are located. An example is in eastern Canada located between Quebec and Ontario where the Mohawk live. They call this moon TSIOTHOHRHKÓ:WA which means BIGGER COLD MOON. If you could name this moon using descriptive language what would you call it? Once you have come up with a name for the moon, try doing some research to find all the different names for this moon. Have a beautiful month.
